FOR A PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

UPON READING the annexed Declaration of Eric Vaughn-Flam, dated January 30, 2018; the Declaration of Joel Phillips dated January 19, 2018; the Declaration of Mona Davids dated January 23, 2018; the Declaration Matt Koller dated January 17, 2018; the exhibits annexed thereto; and the Memorandum of Law in Support of Plaintiff's Motion for a Preliminary Injunction, dated January 28, 2018 ; and all pleadings and proceedings relevant to this action, and good and sufficient cause therefor, it is hereby:

ORDERED that Defendants RIDER UNIVERSITY show cause before this Court in Room 1506 of the United States District Court, Southern District of New York, 40 Foley Square, New York N.Y. 10007, on _____, 2018 at _____ o'clock in the _____ noon, or as soon thereafter as counsel can be heard, why an order should not be issued, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65, preliminarily enjoining defendant or other persons acting in concert with the defendant from: 1) taking any action to sell, relocate or close the Westminster Choir

College located in Princeton New Jersey, its programs, degrees or activities; taking any action to make public statements about selling relocating or closing the Westminster Choir College, its programs, degrees or activities; and 3) taking any action to expend the proceeds of defendant's line of credit for \$15 million for any purchase other than Westminster Choir College as required by the 1991 Merger Agreement paragraph 2.1(c) and 2.3: and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the bond requirement of Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(c) is waived as it concerns a matter of public interest; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this Order to Show Cause together with the papers upon which it is based, and the Summons and Complaint, be served on or before the close of business, February 5, 2018 upon the defendant by: filing copies on the Court ECF System which shall be deemed good and sufficient service; and it is.

FURTHER ORDERED that service of opposition papers, if any, be made on or before the 26th day of February, 2018 by filing copies thereof on the Court's ECF system

FURTHER ORDERED that service of reply papers, if any, be made on or before the 12th day of March, 2018 by delivering copies thereof by the Court's ECF system.
